





Bob & Courtney McGregor Campus Outreach | Thailand

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ... " Matthew 28:19

Bob McGregor began attending West Ridge in 2000 while still in high school, and he later graduated from Berry College.

In the summer of 2007, God planted the seed of Bob and Courtney's ministry while on a short-term mission trip-which also happens to be how they met one another.

"We fell in love with the people and felt burdened to do anything we could to reach more Thais for Christ."

In 2011, Bob and Courtney uprooted their lives and moved halfway across the world to Khon Kaen, in the heart of Thailand.

Now serving in Chiang Mai, Thailand, the McGregors invest their time in building relationships with college-aged Thai students with the goal of ultimately introducing them to the person of Jesus. Many of them know very little, if anything, about Jesus.

In a country where less than 1% profess to be Protestant Christians, the McGregors have made a significant impact for the sake of the Gospel in the community of Chiang Mai, discipling seven Thai students who have come to Christ through their ministry.

"We are the hands and feet of not only Christ, but also of our church home here in Thailand," Bob said. "What we do would not be possible without West Ridge and the rest of our ministry partners praying and caring for us back home."

Last September, we celebrated 20 years of ministry as West Ridge Church. To celebrate, we asked that instead of us receiving gifts, we wanted to give gifts away—resulting in the biggest Generosity Experiment we have ever done! We challenged every person who called West Ridge their church home to give a one-time gift of \$20, and you responded BIG.
