



NEXT STEPS | LEADER GUIDE: *Step Two*

GROWING WITH GOD

Be sure to be near your television or streaming device — or have your remote close by so that you can pause the video when prompted.

In Step Two, we will begin talking about the next steps we can take in our relationship with Jesus. Everyone will have a different next step to take. As the group leader, be prayerfully expectant for your group members to take a step in their walk with Jesus.

There are four characteristics for a disciple of Jesus: They will love God, grow in faith, serve others, and share Jesus. The word disciple does not mean “super Christian,” it simply means that the most important thing in an individual’s life is following Jesus and constantly aligning their lives with His will.

Discipleship cannot be done in isolation and must always be done in Christ-centered community. We are the Church, the called out people of God.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

Understand God’s desire for every Christian to grow in discipleship throughout their lives to become fully devoted followers.

GROUP MEETING DETAILS

1. HANG OUT

(about 30 minutes)

As you gather as a group, spend some time connecting and catching up. If your group eats together, do so during this time.
