WEEK 1: MARCH 3

Scripture: Psalm 139:14

Observation: Every person is wonderfully made by God.

Application: I am wonderfully made.

Prayer: Dear God, You are an AWESOME God!

WEEK 2: MARCH 10

Scripture: Genesis 1:26; Acts 17:24; Psalm 46:1; Proverbs 2:6

Observation: God made us creative, helpful, and smart like Him.

Application: I am made in God's image.

Prayer: Dear God, thank you for giving us the ability to be creative, helpful, and smart.

WEEK 3: MARCH 17

Scripture: Luke 12:7, John 3:16

Observation: We are so important to God, He gave His only Son so we can be with Him forever.

Application: I am important to God.

Prayer: Dear God, thank you for making each one of us special.

WEEK 4: MARCH 24

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 16:13-14

Observation: We honor God when we show respect to the bodies He made us.

Application: God made me to respect myself.

Prayer: Dear God, thank You for the amazing bodies YOU have given us.

WEEK 5: MARCH 31

Scripture: Matthew 7:12

Observation: We honor God when we show respect to the people He made.

Application: God made me to respect others.

Prayer: Dear God, help us to remember this week to be kind to others because we're all made by YOU!

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MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room this month, say, "Good morning, I see someone God made. It's you! (Point to child) God made you! And I am SO glad He did."

DRIVE TIME

As you drive, play What Do You Do? Ask your child, "When your body gets dirty, what do you do?" (take a bath) "Before you go to bed, what do you do to your teeth?" (brush them) "When someone else is in the restroom, what do you do?" (leave them alone) Continue asking questions that help your child think about how to respect their own body and the bodies of others.

CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray, "Dear God, thank you for making [child's name] smart, creative, and helpful like You. I love being his/her mommy/daddy. Help me to trust that You love my little one even more than I do because You made him/her, and because of that I can totally trust Your plans for him/her! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

BATH TIME

Bath time is a great time to teach your child the correct names of his/her body parts. Turn it into a game! Give your child his/her own sponge or wash cloth. Tell him/her to listen and wash only the body part you name. It won't take too many baths and your child will know the body God made from head to toe!
