

# WHY NICARAGUA?

There are many countries with needs, so why did we choose to be involved in the country of Nicaragua? Here are some facts to consider:

- Nicaragua is the 2nd poorest country in the Western Hemisphere.
- Almost 80% of the population lives on less than \$2/day (www.hdr.undp.org/en/countries/profiles/NIC). The COVID-19 pandemic has caused many people to lose their means of income, making the war on poverty even more difficult!
- Less than 43% of the country is considered Evangelical Christians (<a href="https://joshuaproject.net/countries/NU">https://joshuaproject.net/countries/NU</a>). The need for the Gospel is great!
- The two biggest physical needs in the Nicaraguan villages where we visit are food and water. Many of these villages don't have clean drinking water and children can sometimes go days without food.
- The organization we work with is one of the most dedicated, organized, and missional ministries in the entire country. They keep the team safe but also provide us opportunities to make a significant impact on the people.
- Because of our involvement over the last 10 years, we've been part
  of bringing transformation to villages like The Flags and Rene
  Nunez, two of the poorest villages in the entire country. We've
  helped build churches, homes, a school, a feeding station, wells,
  given financial resources to send over 150 kids to school, and
  provided resources to help them develop an agricultural system.

# RAISING SUPPORT

One reason why many students don't sign up for a Missions Trip is because they don't have the money. The truth is not many families can write a check for the full amount. That's why one of the key aspects of your involvement in these trips is raising funds to help underwrite the cost of the trip. And it is possible!

All gifts are tax deductible (checks should be made payable to West Ridge Church, noting your assigned code in the memo.) In accordance with IRS Contribution Code, these funds, though tracked for administrative purposes in association with your personal code, are not funds specifically for you to use or for your own benefit. These funds will be solicited as contributions, and as such, are non-refundable to either the team member or donor, unless the team member is unable to attend for COVID-19 reasons. In that case, we will give the team member the option of joining a future missions trip using the available funds. That being said, typically funds are to remain in an account for this trip alone, and are non-transferrable towards other trips. NOTE: West Ridge Church does not organize or put on fundraisers, nor is fundraising allowed during services or events.

# Here are some helpful tips about fundraising for this trip:

- Send your support letters out as soon as possible! The longer you wait to do this, the harder
  it will be to meet the financial deadlines. Deadlines are absolute! Failure to meet deadlines
  can result in you not being able to participate on the trip. Members with a balance at the
  time of the trip will be unable to participate.
- You will find a sample letter in this packet. Take the letter, personalize it, copy it, and send it to as many people as you can.
- Also include a self-addressed stamped envelope with every letter your mail out. Put your
  Code in BIG letters and have it come to the WRC office by using the church's address
  below. Once you have been approved to be part of the trip, you will be assigned a personal
  code for accounting purposes. It is important that this code be referenced not only on your
  outgoing envelopes, but also incoming checks.

- · If you have any money to turn in please hand-deliver cash or checks to the WRC Office.
- · Keep a record for yourself of all gifts you receive.
- Cash and checks are ok to turn in but you can also make donations online. If someone
  gives you a check they can receive a tax-deductible receipt from the church. You will also
  be sent a donation link once you register for the trip that people can use to donate online.
  Anyone who makes online donations will also receive a tax-deductible receipt.
- · Never, under any circumstances, mail cash.
- · Send each person who sent you money a 'Thank You' note.

# **RAISING SUPPORT (cont.)**

Raising support for this trip starts with forming a Support Team. Your support team is a group of people who join you in ministry through prayer, encouragement, and financial support. Those who give you money and pray for you are just as important as those who go on the trip.

**Question:** Who do I send letters to? **Answer:** Everyone you can think of!

- Make a list of possible supporters. Pray about who should be on the list. Ask
  God for wisdom. Have your family help you with a list of people too. Your list
  could include relatives, co-workers/parents' co-workers, neighbors, friends,
  teachers, coaches, etc.
- Pray over each letter that you send out. Your faith will increase through this process as you trust God to provide the needed funds.
- · If you need help writing Support Letters and forming a team, we will have a Support Raising Meeting on Sunday, November 7th at 1:00pm in the Discovery Room. During this meeting we will help you develop the heart and practices to effectively raise support for the trip.

# SAMPLE SUPPORT LETTER

Dear		,

I would like to tell you about an exciting opportunity that I have coming up in February 2022. I am going on a mission trip to Nicaragua! For one week, I will be part of a team from West Ridge Church. I will be visiting and ministering with a church, school, and with community outreaches to help impact this area. I will also participate in sharing the Gospel, construction projects, ministering to children, as well as helping serve those struggling with poverty and other issues. My prayer is that I will be an instrument to be used by God.

This trip is being organized and led by West Ridge Church. The pastors leading this trip have had extensive experience in missions and trips to this area.

I would like to invite you to be part of my Support Team. I consider my Support Team to be just as much a part of the trip as I am. Through prayer, encouragement, and financial provision, you are playing a huge role in helping people experience the love of Jesus!

### Answers to Frequently Asked Questions:

- · All gifts are tax deductible (Please make checks payable to West Ridge Church).
- 100% of your gift goes towards underwriting the cost of this trip and the team member will be credited for amount raised. These funds are not transferrable towards other trips in the event the participant is unable to go.
- Each team member is responsible to raise their funds (just like missionaries do).
- My first financial deadline of \$850 is due December 12th to secure my airfare. The balance is due by January 23rd.
- Please reference the code # (not the name) listed on your return envelope in the memo portion of your check. (PERSONAL CODE: HS2202 ). This is very important!

# **Passport Information**

\*Please note: The United States Passport Office is backed up due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Routine service is taking up to 16 weeks to process and expedited service is taking up to 12 weeks. We strongly recommend that you apply for your Passport immediately to ensure that you get it back in time.

Because of COVID-19, some of the requirements and processes have changed to apply for a Passport. As of 9/27/21, the Paulding County Courthouse is not accepting applications, but there are other locations in the area that are.

- Serve/Worship at West Ridge Church on Sunday mornings.

### **Vaccines**

Currently, no routine Vaccines are required for entry into Nicaragua, but several are recommended. The CDC recommends that all people entering the country are up-to-date on their routine vaccines, and there are additional ones (Hep A, Malaria, Yellow Fever, etc) that are optional. You can go to <a href="http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/nicaragua">http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/nicaragua</a> to check for up-to-date vaccine information leading up to the trip.

As of October 1, 2021, COVID-19 Vaccines are not required for International travel. In the event that the CDC changes that policy and makes the COVID-19 Vaccine required to travel to Nicaragua, we will follow those guidelines and all Team Members will be required to be fully vaccinated in order to travel with us in February. In the event that a Team Member signs up for the team and chooses not to be fully vaccinated if required, those funds can be donated to the trip, be transferred to a future West Ridge missions trip, as a last resort, be refunded to the donors.



As of October 1, 2021, Nicaragua requires proof of a negative COVID test within 3 days from the date of travel to gain entry into the country. This means that anyone on our team will need to get a PCR Test no earlier than Thursday, February 17, 2022. In order to get on the flight, each team member will need proof of a negative COVID test in hand. In addition, our whole team will need to be tested in Nicaragua in order to gain access back into the United States. We will work with our team on the ground to have our whole team tested at the end of the week to prepare to return home. NOTE: If a team member tests positive for COVID in Nicaragua, Parents will be notified and some of our adult staff members will remain in Nicaragua at the Mission House with the team member until they test negative and are able to return home.

On the trip, we are looking at the best ways to keep our team safe as well as those we will be ministering too. Masks and other preventative measures may be required at various times on the trip if we feel it is necessary. These guidelines will be communicated at our Team Trainings in January.
