



**Series Overview:** Clank! Beep! Clunk! Kids love robots, especially ones that can transform into something new or have cool abilities. In this four-week series from Jesus' ministry on earth, you'll introduce kids to a different story each week that shows us how God's truths never change, but Jesus changes everything — including us! We'll see that we change when we know who God is, our past doesn't change God's love for us, and that Jesus changes how we see things because Jesus can change anything!

**Bible Story:** Jesus and the Samaritan Woman: John 4:5–42; Romans 5:1–11

**Big Idea:** Our past doesn't change God's love for us.

**Series Memory Verse:** "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:17

### 3. Review the Bible story like this:

**\*Supplies: Bible**

- Today, we got to hear another story about Jesus and how he loved others.
- Do you remember what city He was in during today's story? Yes, it was called Samaria.
- And where did Jesus stop? That's right! At a water well.
  - A well is a special place people would take their buckets to get all their water for the day.
  - Jesus didn't have a bucket. He went to the well for another reason.
  - Jesus walked by this place on purpose because he wanted to talk to a woman that many people had rejected.
- The woman walked up to the well with her bucket ready to go. Jesus asked, "Can I have some water?"
- The woman was so surprised. She didn't expect someone like Jesus to talk to someone like her. (Have everyone do their best surprised face).
- But Jesus talked with her. She found out that Jesus understood everything.
  - Jesus knew about what choices she made, Jesus knew about what kinds of people she hung out with and He even knew about her mistakes.
  - But Jesus also could see she really loved God and wanted to know more about God.
- In fact, Jesus loved her so much that he offered her living water! No, it wasn't real water. Real water runs out. And once you're done drinking, you'll be thirsty again later.
- This is just a cool way to show her that if she believed in Jesus, she could one day live forever with God. Jesus didn't care about what her life was like before. He showed the woman that God still loves her very much. (Have everyone hug themselves and say, "Jesus loves me very much too!")
- How cool that **our past doesn't change God's love for us.**

### 4. Practice the March Memory Verse like this:

- Look up 2 Corinthians 5:17 in the Bible and read it with your family.
- Help the kids learn the first part of the verse using these motions:
