



**Series Overview:** This June we will look at the life of Moses and his time leading the Israelites. We will see that our God truly is the Great I AM, and that He created us with some “I am’s” of our own. We will see that God has a plan for us, that He loves us, that He wants us to follow Him and that He gives us a mission!

**Bible Story:** God’s Plan for Moses (Exodus 2:1-10; 3)

**Big Idea:** God has a plan for me!

**Series Memory Verse:** “I plan to give you hope and a good future.”  
-Jeremiah 29:11b ICB

1. Dance and sing with your family to these songs.

2. Show these two videos to teach the Bible story.

### 3. Review the Bible story like this:

#### **Supplies: Bible**

- Open the Bible to Exodus 2 to show the kids where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions and have all the kids repeat each answer after you say it. *(Do a funny movement and / or a funny voice for each answer and have them try to copy it)*
  1. Who were God's people that were slaves in Egypt? (The Israelites)
  2. Who did God plan to send to rescue his people? (Moses)
  3. What did Moses' mom put him in before she hid him in the river? (a waterproof basket)
  4. Who took Moses to be her son? (Pharaoh's daughter)
  5. What was Moses' job once he left Egypt? (a shepherd)
  6. What did God use to get Moses' attention while he was keeping care of his sheep? (a burning bush)
- Do you guys see how God had plans for Moses' life? The Bible says that God had a plan for each of us before we were even born. Part of His plan is for us to be like Jesus-in how we love, follow, and obey God. We can be like Jesus because Jesus took the punishment for our sin!
- Have everyone say, "Thank you, Jesus," and dance around!

### 4. Practice the June Memory Verse like this:

#### **Supplies: Bible , something red, something yellow, and something green**

- Look up Jeremiah 29:11 in the Bible and read it with your family.
- Help your family learn last part of the ICB translation of this verse with motions:

- Play "Stop, Go, or Very Slow" (like Red Light Green Light)
- Send your family to one side of the room. Explain that their job is to touch the wall on the opposite side of the room, but they must follow the signs in order to get there. Hold up each sign and explain that red means stop, green means go, and yellow means to very slow.
- Hold up a color and encourage everyone to start moving toward the opposite side of the room. Change the colors often to make the game more fun. Send anyone not obeying the signs back to the start to try again.
- Tell your family that God had a plan for Moses. Remind them that Moses obeyed God and followed His plan.
- Point out that God has a special plan for each of their lives, as well...and it is a good plan, so they should obey God and follow His plan!
