Introduction

As Easter approaches, we have such a great opportunity to reach out to the people in our lives who need Jesus. One way we can do that is to invite them to join us at one of our Easter services. Another way is by beginning to pray for them. Praying for the salvation of your friends and family is the best way you can pray for them. 1 Timothy 2:4 tells us that “God desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.” Here are twenty-one ways to pray for yourself, your unbelieving friends, and family members based on Scripture.

Week 1: Day 1

Today let's pray that God will use our *relationship* with those in our lives who need Jesus.

Romans 10:14-15

14 How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? 15 And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

Week 1: Day 2

Today, pray *faithfully and persistently* for those in our lives who need Jesus.

Colossians 4:2

Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

Today let's pray for
opportunities to minister to
them in a way that helps
them see Jesus.

Matthew 5:16

In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Today let's pray for a
burden to plead for
their salvation.

Romans 10:1

Brothers, my heart's desire and
prayer to God for them is that
they may be saved.

Ephesians 6:18-19
