




21 DAYS

Luke 15:17-18


17 But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have more than enough bread, but I perish here with hunger!

Week 3: Day 16



Today let's pray that they
would *come to understand*
God's love for them.

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Week 3: Day 17

Today, pray they would see
they can't earn their salvation
through good works and
that God would extend
His gift of grace to them.

Ephesians 2:8-9

8 For by grace you have been saved
through faith. And this is not your
own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not
a result of works, so that no one may
boast.

Week 3: Day 18

Today let's pray that the Holy Spirit would show them that *Jesus is the only way* to God the Father.

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Week 3: Day 19

Today let's pray that they would *confess* Jesus as Lord and *ask* Him to save them.

Romans 10:13

For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Week 3: Day 20

Today, pray that *God will save them* and raise them up in new life to follow Christ.

Ephesians 2:4-5

4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved.

Week 3: Day 21

Today, pray that they would become *fully devoted followers of Christ* and make disciples.

Matthew 28:19-20

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.
