



**Series Overview:** King Solomon is best known for his wisdom and for building God’s temple. Thankfully, he passed on his wisdom so others could have a strong foundation for building up their faith. In this 5-week series, kids will hear from Solomon and the wisdom he shared about the kind of life God wants to help us build. They’ll see that God gives them directions to follow, listens to their requests, is worthy of their worship, gives them true wisdom, and helps them do big things.

**Bible Story:** The Queen of Sheba Visits: 2 Chronicles 9:1–12

**Big Idea:** God helps us do big things.

**Series Memory Verse:** “If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. He will give it to you.” James 1:5a (NlrV)

## 3. Review the Bible story like this:

### **\*Supplies = a Bible**

- Open the Bible to 2 Chronicles 9 and show your family where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions to review the story...
  - Who was the wise king in today's story? *King Solomon.*
  - From where did Solomon get his wisdom? *God.*
  - How many women asked for the king's help to decide who the baby belonged to? *Two.*
  - How did King Solomon know who the real mother was? *She was the one who did not want the baby to get hurt.*
  - Who gives us true wisdom? *God.*

## 4. Practice the September Memory Verse like this:

### **\*Supplies = a Bible**

- Look up James 1:5 in the Bible and read it to your family.
- Help the kids learn the verse and teach the motions to go along with it:

  - Pretend to be and / or ride different caravan animals / modes of transportation that might have been in the Queen of Sheba's caravan – camels, donkeys, sheep.
  - Tell them that the Queen of Sheba had a lot of things and people traveling with her in what is called a caravan – a line of travelers or animals journeying together.
  - Have your family say the memory verse as they pretend to be / ride the different animals.
  - Next, travel around your house looking for gifts fit for a King...When you find things say why you would want to bring that to King Solomon, and then say the memory verse together before moving on.
