



Series Overview: People often say, "It's about the journey, not the destination," when their travel plans don't work out how they expected. This phrase couldn't have been truer for Job, who went through a shocking journey. In this 4-week series, kids will hear from Job's story as he learned to navigate loss and trust God's itinerary every step of the way. Through the story of Job's perseverance and faithfulness, kids will learn that God is with them no matter what they go through, they can show God's love in small ways, God is bigger than they could ever understand, and they can trust God will make everything right.

- **Big Idea:** God is bigger than we could ever understand.

2. Show this video to teach the Bible story.

3. Review the Bible story like this:

***Supplies = a Bible**

- Open the Bible to Job 42 and show your family where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions to review the story and reference verses in Bible for help...
 - What tragic things happened in Job's life? Job lost his family, his possessions, and his health. What can we have been learning about? *Job*.
 - Can you name some things Job lost? *His family, animals, and his health.*
 - How did God make things right for Job? *God gave him more than he ever had before.*
 - When things seem bad, who can make things right? God!
 - We can trust God will make everything right.

4. Practice the October Memory Verse like this:

***Supplies = a Bible and a beach type ball or a balloon**

- Look up Psalm 121:8 in the Bible and read it to your family.
- Help the kids learn the verse and teach the motions to go along with it:

- Play with your family keeping the ball or balloon up in the air.
- Say the verse as you hit the ball/ balloon to each other.
- When the ball / balloon drops, pick it back up and make it right again by throwing it back in the air and starting again.
- Remind the kids that God is always watching over us and that He can make anything right again...anything!
