KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Leading Worship

- Lead worship in various worship environments: kids ministry, student ministry, young adults, Sunday morning, prayer night, and special events.
- Occasionally lead in place of the Worship Pastor in Sunday morning services,
- Prepare musically: know arrangements, chords, and lyrics from memory.
- Prepare all spoken portions with great consideration for theme, spiritual direction, and flow of the service.

Coordinating Worship Experiences

- Oversee the purchase, storage and implementation of all charts, tracks and mp3 uploads for each worship environment.
- Coordinate and oversee all musical elements and band for kids ministry, student ministry and young adult services. Incorporate music that connects to a multi-cultural audience of NW Atlanta and West Ridge Church.
- Work with worship pastor to schedule musicians and singers appropriately to execute planned elements. Musicians scheduled 4 weeks in advance.
- Maintain Planning Center on a weekly basis for each worship environment making sure all elements are posted accurately in a timely manner. Set lists posted at least 2 weeks in advance.

Creative Team

- Meet weekly with Creative team to evaluate, brainstorm, plan, and execute excellent worship services.
- Actively participate in critiquing worship services, welcome constructive feedback and implement direction.
- Contribute new and creative ideas related to the overall program and service development.
- Work with Creative Pastor and Worship Pastor to implement a worship philosophy, structure, and culture throughout West Ridge Church.

Band Development

- Enlist, evaluate and encourage the musicians and singers across every ministry area.
- Facilitate auditions for musicians and singers throughout the church and assist in follow up to get new team members plugged in.
- Meet with team members one on one and in groups regularly to build relationships, encourage and inspire.

- Spirit filled leader, heart for the local church, a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and passion to use music to reach others.
- A solid understanding of music theory and the ability to create charts, arrange music, and communicate effectively with other musicians, no matter their skill level.

- A gifted musician/vocalist who possesses the unique ability to connect with a multi-cultural audience to lead extraordinary worship experiences.
- A true minister who is driven with a passion for worship and a calling to serve the local church.
- A born leader who instinctively knows how to recruit, develop and shepherd volunteers.
- A team player that enjoys collaborating and leading others to produce excellent worship environments.
- A highly creative individual who is motivated to dream of new and innovative ways to connect with a diverse culture.
- A highly organized person able to multi-task and manage details related to producing excellent worship services.
- A self-aware individual committed to improvement through personal and group evaluation.
