- **Big Idea:** I believe God can speak to me.

3. Review the Bible story like this:

*Supplies = a Bible

- Open the Bible to Luke 3 and show your family where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions to review the story...
 - > Who was the man in the story who baptized people? John the Baptist.
 - > Who did John baptize in our story today? Jesus
 - > What did God's Spirit look like when it came down from the sky? A dove.
 - > Who spoke when Jesus was baptized? God
 - > Can God speak to you? Yes!
- Let's say our Big Idea together: I believe God can speak to me.
- 4. Practice the January Memory Verse like this:

*Supplies = a Bible

- Look up John 6:69 in the Bible and read it to your family.
- Talk about how John knew and believed that Jesus was the Holy One of God and that we can know and believe that too.
- Help your family learn the verse and teach the motions to go along with it.

Preschool Verse

- Play a game of "Simon Says" but call it "Teacher Says" instead.
- Every once in a while, say that Teacher Says to say the memory verse and do the motions.
- Talk to your family about how they can also know and believe that Jesus is the holy one of God!
