



Series Overview:

Using your imagination to create brilliant pieces of art or intriguing inventions is super cool and super important! Sometimes, the things you create can help solve a need or show the world something amazing about who God is. Today’s Lesson...

Bible: Elisha and the Famine (2 Kings 4:38–44)

Big Idea: God helps us solve big problems.

Lesson Guide:

1. Dance and sing with your child to these songs.

2. Show this video to teach the Bible story.

3. Review the Bible story like this:

***Supplies = a Bible**

- Open the Bible to 2 Kings 4 and show the kids where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions to review the story...
 - What was the big problem in today's Bible story? *A famine. There was not enough food in the land.*
 - What did Elisha do when the stew tasted bad? *He added flour.*
 - How many people did Elisha feed with twenty loaves of bread? *One hundred.*
 - Who helped Elisha with these problems? *God.*
 - Who can help us solve big problems? *God! God helps us solve big problems.*

4. Practice the July Memory Verse like this:

***Supplies = a Bible, bread, a can of soup, vegetables or other food items**

- Look up Ephesians 2:10 and read it to your family.

- Next try this game with your family...
 - Hide the food items around a room while your family members are not watching.
 - Then say the verse together and have them find the food items.
 - Remind your family that God provided Elisha and the prophets a way to make poisonous plants okay to eat so they could have some stew and then later God used Elisha to feed 100 men with only 20 loaves of bread...there just kept being more and more bread until all the men had plenty to eat! God helped them with their problem of not having enough food!
 - Encourage your family that God has good works for us to do even in the midst of big and small problems that we face here on earth! Let's look to Him to help us to do good things and to help us work through any problem that comes our way!
