



Series Overview:

Inventors take ordinary objects and transform them into extraordinary innovations with some creativity and a lot of tinkering. But Jesus didn't need tools, blueprints, or a workshop to make extraordinary things happen. On the outside, Jesus may have seemed ordinary, but his life, actions, and love regularly defied expectations. - **Big Idea:** Jesus trusted God!

3. Review the Bible story like this:

***Supplies = a Bible**

- Open the Bible to Luke 4 and show your family where today's story comes from.
- Ask the following questions to review the story...
 - **How long was Jesus in the wilderness for?** 40 days.
 - **How many times was Jesus tempted?** Three times.
 - **What did Jesus say each time the devil tempted him?** He said no! He trusted God.
 - **How did Jesus trust God?** He listened to God's words even when the devil tried to tempt him with things that looked good.
 - **How can you trust God?** Reading your Bible and remembering how much God loves you and takes care of you.
 - **Jesus trusted God.**

4. Practice the January Memory Verse like this:

***Supplies = a Bible**

- Look up Philippians 2:9 and read the verse and teach the motions to go along with it.

- Set some chairs up that you and your child could weave through or go around. Also, set some obstacles out that you would walk, crawl, or jump over or go under.
- Have your child close their eyes and cover them with one hand and hold your hand with their other hand.
- Say the January memory verse together and then lead your child through the "obstacle course." Encourage them to trust you along the way.
- When you get through the course, celebrate together and say the January memory verse again.
- Then trade roles.
- You can change up how you go through the chairs...maybe hopping like a bunny, crawling like a cat, wiggling like a worm, etc.
- Talk about...
 - In this game, you really had to trust your partner. Today's Bible story was about the time Jesus was all alone in the wilderness, and he had to trust God.
 - Our verse tells us that Jesus is above all others! He is more trustworthy than anyone else, as well! You can trust Jesus!
