



### **Series Overview:**

3. Review the Bible story like this:

#### **\*Supplies = a Bible**

- Open the Bible to Genesis 21-22 and show your family where today's story comes from.

- Ask the following questions to review the story...
  - What did God provide for Abraham and Sarah even though they were very old?  
A baby.
  - What was the baby boy's name?  
Isaac.
  - Why did Abraham take Isaac up the mountain?  
God asked Abraham to give up his son.
  - Did God take Abraham's son away?  
No! God sent an angel to stop him.
  - What did God provide instead?  
A ram.
  - Who can we always trust to provide for us?  
God!
  - We can trust God to provide.

#### 4. Practice the July Memory Verse like this:

***\*Supplies = a Bible and cups or blocks or other building supplies***

- Look up Ephesians 5:1-2 and read the verse and teach the motions to go along with it.

  - For this activity, build an altar with your family like the one Abraham and Isaac built.
  - You can also build the tallest altar, the widest, and in different shapes (circle, triangle, square).

- Talk about...
  - How God provided the ram for Abraham and Isaac and how God provides for us still today!
  - How we can follow God's example and provide for others, as well!
